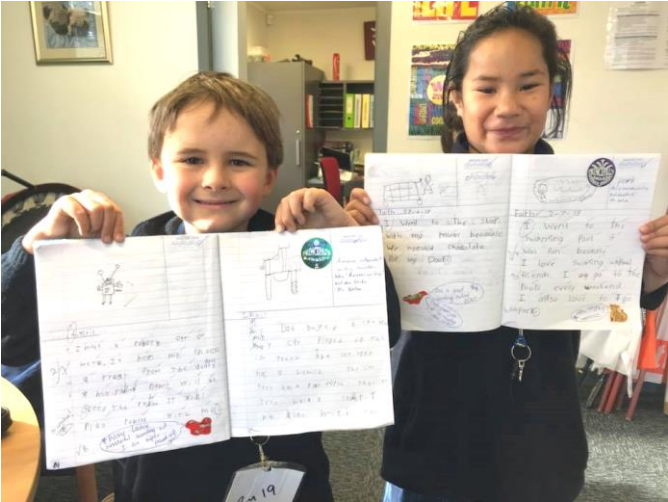

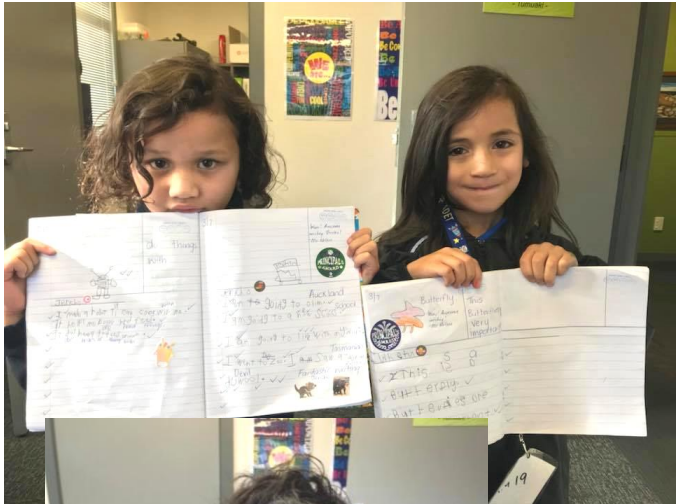

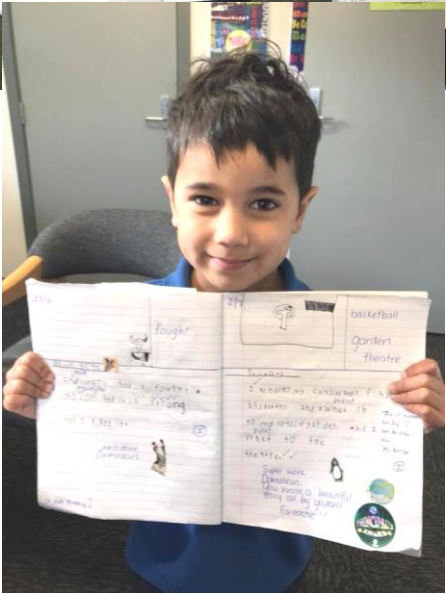
Community Garden
